The Chalice



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Solution: The paten is the small dish in which the consecrated hosts are placed during the Eucharist. The ciborium is a covered cup in which the consecrated hosts are kept and distributed to the faithful at the time of communion. The cruetts and the tray are two small jugs that receive the wine and water offered in the chalice. The chalice is a cup-shaped vessel, usually supported by a foot, with a stem ending in a knot, in which the priest consecrates the wine during the Eucharist.

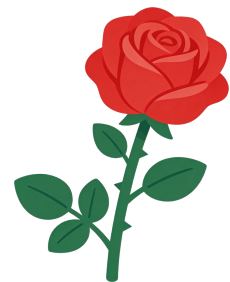
At the end of Mass, the ciborium returns to the
