An angel comes to speak to Cloclo during the night.

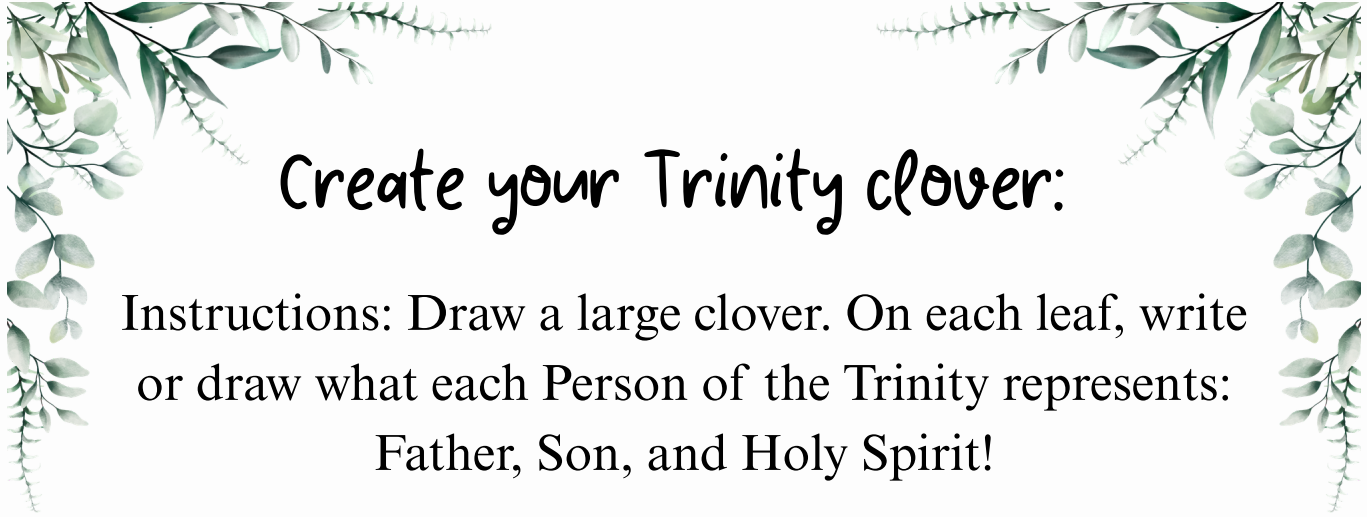
Saint Patrick picks up Cloclo and explains the Trinity.
